Mao by Rumiko Takahashi (Ongoing)

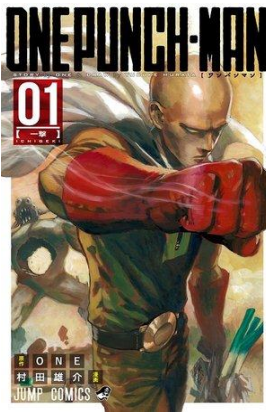

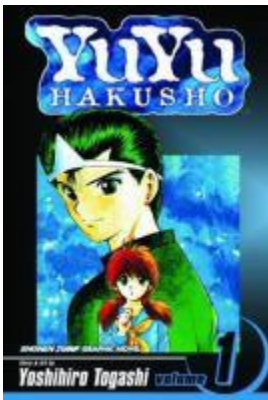
One-Punch Man by ONE (Ongoing)
